St. Regis Bal Harbour Resort, Miami Beach, Florida ho The specs: A 243-room beach resort 30 minutes from Miami International Airport but far above Floridian norms, with a Jean-Georges restaurant and a sublime spa. The look: Utterly glamorous, from a high-ceilinged lobby lined with faceted mirrors to a check-in area with marble floors and ceilings (and a glass of cava as a welcome drink). The massive rooms have mother-of-pearl-inlaid tables in the foyers, walk-in closets, and oceanview balconies—the perfect place to enjoy a leisurely room-service meal. The experience: Bal Harbour is best known for its luxury mall, and the St. Regis has given power shoppers a place to stay after days spent stocking up on Dolce & Gabbana dresses and Tod's loafers across the street. But even the lure of a new Chanel bag might not be enough to tear you away from the St. Regis's private cabanas and palm-fringed pools, where staff are on hand to give a foot rub during a hard day of sunbathing. The J&G Grill is good for the fresh fish on which the modellike guests subsist. If only: The compound-esque exteriors were less blah. The room to book: Every room is large and luxe; suites come with a personal butler at your beck and call (305-993-3300; doubles from \$479). 😡 📵 🛈 🥮 🚱 🚯
